TN Ready Achievement Test	3-8	This test is given to comply with Every Student Succeeds Act §1177 and Tennessee Code Annotated (T.C.A.) §49-1602.	TN Ready assessment measures a student's skills in English Language Arts, math, science and social studies in grades 6-8, ELA, mathematics, and science for grades 3-5. TN Ready Achievement: student score provides a raw score that is used to calculate course grade for report cards [currently 15% of 2nd semester grades (grades 3-5) & 15% of 2nd semester grades (grades 6-8)] Test results are used in teacher, school and district accountability with the State of Tennessee and the Federal Government. Results also count for 10% of a student's final grade in each subject.	TCAP ACH grades 3-8 Tentative: TCAP grades 3-5 April 15 – April 30, 2024 TCAP- Grades 6-8: April 15 – May 3, 2024	"Quickscore" results are expected within 3 weeks of the test administration. The quickscores are converted using the cube root method by the district testing coordinator and sent to teachers to use for final grades. Later the state releases more detailed individual student reports. District office staff distribute these reports to schools to share with parents in the fall.

All students are expected to participate in all tests mandated in federal regulations and/or state law.
